

## **QUESTION:**

How can the GoHigherKY.org website help students at a College Fair?

### **Academic Expectations:**

**1.1** Students use reference tools such as dictionaries, almanacs, encyclopedias, and computer reference programs and research tools such as interviews and surveys to find the information they need to meet specific demands, explore interests or solve specific problems.

**1.16** Students use computers and other kinds of technology to collect, organize and communicate information and ideas.

### **Core Concepts:**
