

General information

The following pages provide information about costs, admissions, financial aid and majors at Kentucky colleges. **In addition to tuition and fees and room and board, there are other costs associated with college: books, supplies, transportation and personal costs.** Some schools that don't have on-campus housing have provided figures showing the housing cost they use in figuring the cost of attendance. We have estimated costs for schools that did not provide them.

Information in this chapter will almost certainly change before you start college. For the most up-to-date information, contact the school you plan to attend.

Included in this section is information about Kentucky four-year and two-year degree-granting colleges and universities and seminaries. Four-year, degree-granting schools offer bachelor's degrees, and many offer advanced degrees as well. Two-year, degree-granting schools offer associate degrees, and many also offer certificates and diplomas. Seminaries offer advanced degrees in theological studies. The final section has information about schools whose programs lead to diplomas or certificates rather than two- or four-year degrees.
