ACHIEVE adult program: At least 25 years old (or 23–24 with 2 years of full-time work experience) and at least 39 semester credit hours from accredited colleges.
Traditional program: ACT or SAT and high school diploma with at least 2.5 GPA or GED.

Criteria used to determine nontraditional status: Age 25 or older (or age 23–24 with 2 years of full-time work experience)

Placement/credit examinations: AP, CLEP, credit by demonstrated competency
