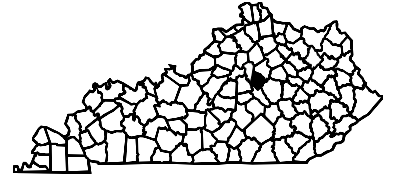

**Admission requirements:** Four-year baccalaureate with minimum 2.75 GPA. Admissions essay, official transcripts and four personal references required. MAT (for DMin and master's students who don't have a 2.5 cumulative GPA), GRE (for PhD students or as a substitute for the MAT), and TOEFL (minimum score of 550 for master's programs, 600 for PhD programs) or IELTS (minimum score of 7 for master's programs, 7.5 for PhD programs) required.
