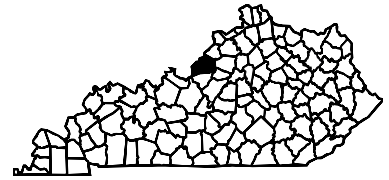

Admission requirements: ACT or SAT. Upper half of high school class, precollege curriculum, 2.5 GPA, 21 ACT or 1000 SAT. Must meet Bellarmine Admission Committee recommendations. If out of high school for five or more years, ACT/SAT not required.

Criteria used to determine nontraditional status: Age 24 or older

Placement/credit examinations: AP, CLEP, institutional test, institutional/proficiency examination

Application deadlines: Two weeks before registering. The admission application deadline for students applying for scholarship consideration is February 1. Early action deadline is November 1. Transfer admission and adult admission: rolling.

Advance tuition deposit (freshmen only) : \$300 (refundable until May 1)
