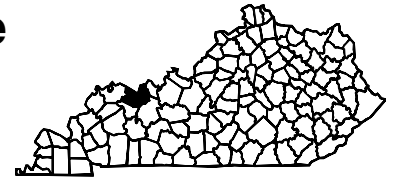

Admission requirements: ACT or SAT required. 2.5 or higher GPA, 18 ACT or 890 SAT. ACT/GPA scores lower than the above will be evaluated by the Admissions Committee.

Criteria used to determine nontraditional status: Out of high school more than five years

Placement/credit examinations: AP, CLEP, institutional test

Application deadlines: Rolling
The priority admission application deadline for students applying for scholarship consideration is March 1.

Pre-enrollment fees and deposits:
Enrollment deposit: \$200 (\$100 orientation fee/\$100 housing fee)
Commuter students only need to pay the \$100 orientation fee.
This fee is refundable until May 1.
