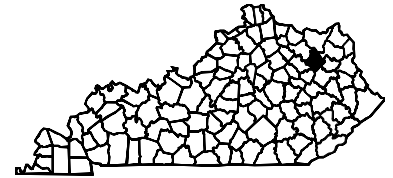

Admission requirements: ACT or SAT. Admission index (computed by using high school GPA and ACT scores [18 minimum score]). Completion of precollege curriculum (Kentucky residents).

Criteria used to determine nontraditional status: Age 23 or older, divorced, married and/or parent

Placement/credit examinations: AP, CLEP

Application deadlines: No application deadline for most programs. Scholarship deadline is March 15.
