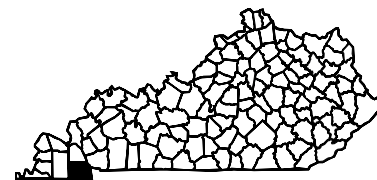




# Murray State University

**Admission requirements:** ACT. Accredited high school diploma or GED. Students must complete precollege curriculum for baccalaureate admission, rank in top half of class, and have a composite score of 18 or higher on the ACT.
