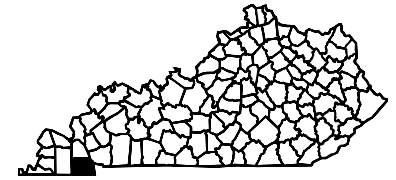

Admission requirements: ACT/SAT. Accredited high school diploma or GED. Students must complete precollege curriculum, rank in top half of class or have a 3.0 GPA, and have a composite score of 18 or higher on the ACT or an 870 combined verbal and math score on the SAT.

Criteria used to determine nontraditional status: Age and/or married, full-time employee, parent, or veteran

Placement/credit examinations: AP, CLEP, institutional test
