

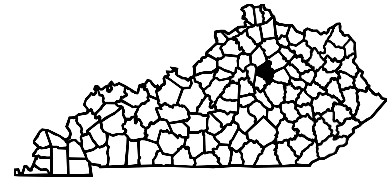

Application deadlines: Fall: December 1 (Early Action)
February 1 (regular decision)
Spring: December 1
