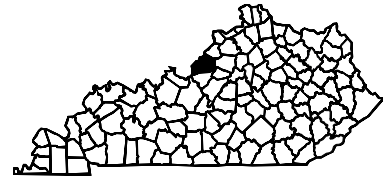

**Criteria used to determine nontraditional status:** Age 25 or older and a high school graduate or GED recipient for adult students

**Placement/credit examinations:** AP, CLEP, COMPASS, institutional test/placement tests, IB, TOEFL, DSST

**Application deadlines:** January 15 for students applying for scholarship consideration; February 15 (priority) for new freshmen; March 15 for adult, community college transfer, and Phi Theta Kappa. Transfer students should apply at least 6 weeks prior to term.
