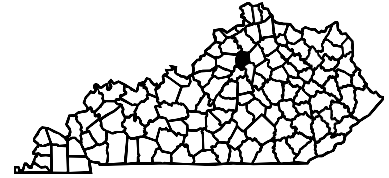

**Admission requirements:** ACT (preferred) or SAT.  
Admission index of at least 430, determined by using a high school GPA on a 4.0 scale x 100 and test scores of ACT (preferred) or SAT (converted to ACT equivalent) x 10. Precollege curriculum requirements and remove any deficiencies within the first 24 credit hours. Students with admission index below 430 are granted conditional admission.
