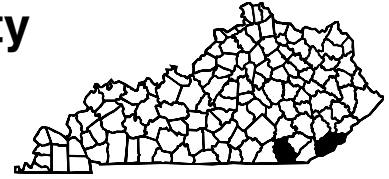

Lincoln Memorial University is a private university with two Kentucky campuses: Baptist Regional Medical Center, 1 Trillium Way, Corbin, KY 40701, and Southeast Community College, 700 College Road, Cumberland, KY 40823.
