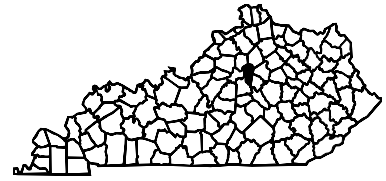

Midway College is a private college for women (men can enroll in the evening School for Career Development and online college) in Woodford County, with branch campuses in Cynthiana, Danville, Frankfort, Harrodsburg, Hazard, Louisville, Maysville, Mount Vernon, Prestonsburg, Shelbyville and Harrodsburg.
