KHEAA, Career Cruising to provide free training on Individual Learning Plans

FRANKFORT, Ky. (March 23, 2011) — The Kentucky Higher Education Assistance Authority (KHEAA) and Career Cruising will host free Individual Learning Plan (ILP) training for private school, home school and adult students in April and May 2011. Training will be offered through webinars and at five private schools across the state.

Webinars focusing on student use of the ILP will be held:

- Tuesday, April 5, and Tuesday, May 3, from 1 to 2 p.m. Eastern time, noon to 1 p.m. Central time.
- Wednesday, April 6, and Wednesday, May 4, from 3 to 4 p.m. Eastern time, 2 to 3 p.m. Central time.

Webinars focusing on school administrator use of the ILP will be held:

- Thursday, April 7, from 4 to 5 p.m. Eastern time, 3 to 4 p.m. Central time.
- Wednesday, May 4, from noon to 1 p.m. Eastern time, 11 a.m. to noon Central time.

On-site training will cover student and administrator use, as well as KHEAA's new College Cost & Planning Reports, and will be held from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. local time on:
