Academic Excellence Scholarship

Eligibility: The applicant must:

- be a graduate of an accredited high school.
- have at least a 3.7 GPA.
- have at least a 24 ACT composite.
- be enrolled at least 6 credit hours.
- maintain a 3.0 GPA.

Award: \$3,000; available for fall and spring semesters

Academic Honors Scholarship

Eligibility: The applicant must:

- be a graduate of an accredited high school.
- have at least a 3.25 GPA.
- have at least a 20 ACT score.
- be enrolled at least 6 credit hours.
- maintain a 2.75 GPA.

Award: \$2,000; available for fall and spring semesters

Ambassador Scholarship

Eligibility: The applicant must:

- have at least a 3.25 GPA.
- have at least a 20 ACT score.
- be enrolled full time in the spring and fall semesters, half time in the summer semester.
- maintain a 2.75 GPA.
- comply with all Ambassador policies and procedures.
- attend a mandatory orientation session.

Award: Tuition and fees up to 19 hours per semester

Career Technical Honors Scholarship

Eligibility: The applicant must:
