An incoming freshman must also submit at least one letter of reference from a high school counselor or teacher, a copy of ACT or SAT scores, and transcripts from all high schools attended (including the most recent final course grades issued).

A transferring college student must also submit at least one letter of academic endorsement from a professor or dean, and transcripts from all previous colleges.
