- maintain at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA.
- not fail any course.

- not withdraw from the university during the semester.

Award: \$250 per semester hour for full-time students, \$330 per semester hour for part-time students

Home School Student Scholarship

Eligibility: The applicant must:

- be a home-school graduate.
- be a first-time freshman.

- have no previous college experience.
- be enrolled at least half-time.
- maintain at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA.
- not fail any course.
- not drop a course during the semester.
- not withdraw from the university during the semester.

Award: Special tuition rate of \$250 per semester hour for full-time students, \$330 per semester hour for part-time students

Law Enforcement and First Responders Tuition Award

Stump Entrepreneurial Scholarship

Eligibility: The applicant must:

- be an incoming freshman.

- submit an application and essay.

Art Scholarship

Eligibility: Based on a portfolio and a personal interview.

The portfolio should contain only 2-dimensional work. Three-dimensional work and large work should be presented as photographs or on CD or DVD.

The portfolio should include a:

- portrait or self-portrait in graphite from life, not from a photograph.
- still life in color.
- hand or foot.
- perspective.
- mixed media drawing.
- short written artist statement.

Sketchbooks are encouraged. Portfolios should be brought to the Doris Wainwright Kennedy Art Center on the day of the competition.

Art History Scholarship

Music Scholarship

Eligibility: Determined by audition and interview. Composition scholarships are based on the student's original work.

Singers are expected to sing at least 2 songs from memory in contrasting style.

Pianists are expected to play from memory 2 pieces of at least the difficulty of the Bach Inventions or the sonatas of Haydn or Mozart.

Organists are expected to play one of the easier Bach preludes and fugues or works of comparable difficulty and to show competence on the piano.

Instrumentalists or guitarists should play 2 pieces or etudes in contrasting styles.

Composers should bring 2 or more original compositions and recordings (if available) with them.

Students interested in church music or music history should audition in their principal instrument.
