Admission requirements: Unconditional admission: ACT - 20 and above (composite), SAT 950 and above (critical reading and math), high school GPA of 2.0 on 4.0 scale. Conditional admission: ACT 18-19 (Composite), SAT 870-940 (critical reading and math), high school GPA 2.0 on a 4.0 scale. Students out of high school more than 8 years or 25 or older are exempt from test score requirements.
