

Two-Year Public Colleges

Programs in Kentucky Community and Technical College System (KCTCS) schools last from 6 to 24 months and can lead to diplomas, certificates and associate's degrees. Some programs are designed to transfer for credit at four-year colleges and universities. Others are technical programs that teach students specific occupational skills or improve their present job skills.

In addition to the programs listed in this section, all of the KCTCS schools participate in the following state and federal student aid programs:

State: College Access Program Grant, Kentucky National Guard programs, Vocational Rehabilitation, Kentucky Educational Excellence Scholarship, Kentucky Transportation Civil Engineering Scholarship and state waivers. KCTCS Scholarships

KCTCS offers the following scholarships to Kentucky residents. Please check under the school you are interested in attending for additional criteria and contact information.

Commonwealth Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be a Kentucky resident; be a current year high school valedictorian, a salutatorian or in the upper 10% of the current high school graduating class, or a valedictorian who graduated from high school during the previous academic year; and demonstrate financial need.

Charles E. Cranmer-Liquid

Transporters Inc. Tuition Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be the child of an active employee with at least 1 year of service or the child of an employee who died while employed and whose spouse has not remarried, be enrolled full-time, meet satisfactory academic progress and demonstrate financial need. Children of officers and directors of Liquid Transporters are not eligible. Application must first be made to the Human Resources Office of Liquid-Transporters, then to the financial aid office of the selected college.

Award: Renewable for 6 semesters if full-time enrollment is maintained, at least a 2.5 GPA is maintained, and funds are available

Kentucky Colonels

Better Life Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be a full-time student in pursuit of an associate's degree; be a single working parent with at least 1 child under the age of 12; work part time; and demonstrate financial need, enthusiasm for learning and potential for academic success.

Award: \$2,500 each year; renewable for a second year with full-time enrollment and satisfactory academic progress toward the completion of a degree as determined by the college scholarship committee

Number: 32, 2 in each KCTCS college district

President's Scholarship

Eligibility: Must demonstrate outstanding academic performance and financial need. Each college has additional criteria.

John T. Smith Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be a minority student, attend at least 1 academic year at least half time, maintain a 2.5 GPA, plan to attend a 4-year school and demonstrate financial need.

Additional criteria may apply at individual colleges.

Toyota Motor Manufacturing, Kentucky Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be enrolled in a degree-seeking program in the automotive field, maintain a 3.0 GPA and demonstrate financial need

Eligibility: Must be a full-time student; major in business or an allied field, such as accounting; and reside in Boyd, Carter, Greenup or Lawrence County, Kentucky, or Cabell, Lawrence or Ohio County, West Virginia.

Disabled Student Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be a sophomore, have demonstrated potential for academic success, have at least a 3.0 GPA, have a permanent physical disability (preferably neurological in nature), be pursuing a degree in a medical field (including counseling and psychology), be focused and have clear education goals and a strong work ethic.

Endowment Fund Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be enrolled in the nursing program and demonstrate satisfactory academic progress.

Chellgren-Ashland Community and Technical College Fund Scholarship

Eligibility: Preference given to a current or former resident of the Ramey-Estep Home who demonstrates financial need and potential for academic success.

Clark Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be a Boyd County High School graduate and demonstrate financial need and potential for academic excellence.

Harry C. Ferguson II Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be a Kentucky resident, demonstrate financial need and the potential for academic success and have at least a 2.5 GPA.

Fifth Third Bank Scholarship

Eligibility: Must demonstrate an interest in a banking or business career.

Galloway Trust Scholarship

Eligibility: Must have attended high school in Boyd or Greenup County, have at least a 3.3 GPA and demonstrate the potential to pursue a baccalaureate degree program at a college or university in Kentucky.

Grayson Rural Electric Lineman's Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be a student in the lineman program, reside on Grayson Electric lines and have a 2.5 GPA.

Griffith Delaney Hillman & Company Scholarship

Eligibility: Must demonstrate potential for academic success. Preference given to a student who has indicated an interest in an accounting career.

Robert B. Hilton Education Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be a Paul G. Blazer High School graduate, have resided in Boyd County for at least 3 years, be enrolled in a transfer curriculum and demonstrate financial need.

Agnes Burnette Johnson Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be a graduate of Boyd County High School, show potential for academic success and demonstrate financial need.

Fyffe Jones Group Accounting Award

Eligibility: Must be a full-time student who has completed the first year of accounting

studies and has demonstrated academic success.

Eligibility: Must be a graduate of a Kentucky high school.

Rue Kennard Kelley Endowment Scholarship

Eligibility: Must demonstrate potential for academic success.

Kentucky Power Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be a nontraditional student; demonstrate financial need and academic excellence; be from Kentucky; and be a full-time, degree-seeking student.

Kentucky Power Lineman Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be a female or a minority, show potential for academic success and have financial need.

King's Daughters and Sons Foundation of Kentucky, Inc. Associate Degree Nursing Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be a second-year student in the associate's degree nursing program.

Anne Kouns Student Aid Fund Scholarship

Eligibility: Must demonstrate financial need and potential for academic success.

Lottie B. Culinary Arts Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be a third-semester culinary arts student, have at least a 2.25 GPA, demonstrate financial need, have necessary skills for the profession and be recommended by a culinary arts faculty member.

Joseph and Sylvia Mansbach Scholarship

Eligibility: Must demonstrate potential for academic success, have financial need and/or work at least 10 hours a week during the academic term and demonstrate academic progress toward educational goals.

Marathon Petroleum Kevin McClain Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be a full-time student, be enrolled in the applied process technology program and have at least a 2.0 GPA. Preference given to a minority or female student.

Norma Ruth Wells Mason Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be a student in pre-engi-

neering or electrical technology and have a 2.5 cumulative GPA.

David N. Michalak Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility: Must have at least a 3.0 GPA and have completed at least 24 semester hours at ACTC.

Morning Pointe Foundation Practical Nursing Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be a second-semester practical nursing student and be a Boyd, Carter or Greenup County resident. Preference given to a student interested in pursuing a career in senior care and/or geriatric nursing.

Pre-Engineering Scholarship

Eligibility: Must have at least a 3.5 GPA, have at least a 20 composite ACT score with a 20 math ACT score or SAT equivalent, and plan to enroll in a 4-year college engineering program following completion of an associate's in science at ACTC.

Joe Thomas Rupert Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be a full-time student, have at least a 3.0 GPA, have an 18 ACT score, have potential for academic success and demonstrate financial need.

Scholarship and Talent Grant Endowment

Eligibility: Must be a deserving full-time or part-time student.

Lincoln and Katherine Morgan Scott Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be from Boyd or Lewis County.

Barbara Seibert Student Aid Fund Scholarship

Eligibility: Must demonstrate financial need and potential for academic success.

Theodore C. and Bennie J. Shields Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be a graduate of Boyd County High School, demonstrate financial need and potential for academic success and maintain at least a 3.0 GPA. At least half of the scholarships granted must go to female students.

Eligibility: Must be the deserving child of a Boyd County firefighter or police officer who has been employed full time by the department for at least 2 years.

Toyota Young Women Lead Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be a female student, have a 3.0 high school GPA, have the potential for academic success and demonstrate financial need. Preference given to a participant in the Young Women LEAD Conference.

Troy B. and Sophia Wheeler Memorial Trust Endowment Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be from northeastern Kentucky and be enrolled in a health science program.

Goldie Wilson Scholarship

Eligibility: Must demonstrate potential for academic success.

Susan Wilson Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be a graduate of Lawrence County High School, have at least a 2.5 GPA and demonstrate potential for academic success and financial need.

YWCA Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be female, reside in Boyd or Greenup County, be deserving, have financial need, have at least a "B" average and apply for Pell Grant funding.

Big Sandy College Educational Foundation Endowed Scholarship

Eligibility: Must demonstrate the potential for achieving academic excellence, be enrolled in a program that contributes to workforce development in a high-need area and/or plan to transfer.

Eligibility: Must be a Hispanic/Latino student and complete the FAFSA.

Big Sandy Mended Hearts Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be a resident of the Big Sandy area (Floyd, Johnson, Knott, Magoffin, Martin and Pike counties); be a second-semester student enrolled in the nursing program; have at least a 2.5 GPA; and demonstrate potential for academic success.

Bluegrass Endowed Scholarship

Eligibility: Must demonstrate financial need and potential for academic success.

Bocook Engineering Inc. Endowed Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be a full-time student with at least a 3.0 GPA and major in a technical field such as math, science or engineering. If more than 1 applicant qualifies, preference will be given to the child of a current employee of Bocook Engineering.

Eligibility: Must demonstrate financial need and potential for academic success.

Claude V. Chandler Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be a Paintsville High School graduate, be a mathematics or physics major, score highest in class in mathematics on the ACT or SAT and maintain satisfactory academic progress. If several students of equal rank apply, the award goes to the student with the highest financial need as determined by the FAFSA. If no student is eligible based on these requirements, the award will be given based on academic standing.

Eligibility: Must be a full-time student, have at least a 2.5 high school GPA and be a graduating senior from a Floyd County high school. Preference given to a business major.

James B. Cole Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be a sophomore; have at least a 3.0 GPA in accounting, finance or economics; and plan to transfer to a 4-year college.

Valerie A. Cole Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be a sophomore with at least a 3.0 GPA in the area of human services, social work or counseling and plan to transfer to a 4-year college.

Eligibility: Must be a student from Johnson Central or Paintsville High School, major in criminal justice or law enforcement and not be receiving financial aid.

Eligibility: Must be a single parent at least 30 years of age, be a full-time student, be a resident of Letcher or Pike County and qualify for maximum financial aid.

Betty M. Dorton Nursing Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be a second-year nursing student. Preference given to a student from Johnson County.

William G. Duke Endowed Scholarship
Eligibility: Must be a full-time student and demonstrate the potential for achieving academic success.

East Point Area Development Club Endowment Fund Scholarship
Eligibility: Must reside in the East Point area, have potential for academic success and maintain satisfactory academic progress.

Dr. George D. Edwards Scholarship
Eligibility: Must demonstrate the potential for achieving academic success.

Equitable Resources/Kentucky-West Virginia Gas Scholarship
Eligibility: Must be a Floyd, Johnson, Knott, Lawrence, Leslie, Letcher, Magoffin, Martin, Perry or Pike County resident; be pursuing courses in a health-related profession or education; score the highest in the applicant's graduating class on the ACT or SAT; maintain satisfactory progress; and demonstrate financial need.

First Commonwealth Bank Scholarship
Eligibility: Must be a full-time student, be a resident of Floyd County, have at least a 3.0 GPA and demonstrate financial need due to not receiving any grants.

Bill Fitzwater Scholarship
Eligibility: Must be a full-time student, have at least a 2.5 GPA, have served in the U.S. Armed Forces, not be receiving any grant money, demonstrate financial need and be a resident of the Big Sandy service area.

Chris Fleming Memorial Scholarship
Eligibility: Must be a full-time student, have at least a 3.0 GPA and submit a proposal for wellness called "Building a Better You."

Melissa M. Forsyth Endowed Scholarship
Eligibility: Must be enrolled in a program that contributes to workforce development in a high-need area, plan to transfer to a bachelor's degree in Kentucky and demonstrate the potential for achieving academic success.

Highlands Regional Medical Center Endowed Scholarship
Eligibility: Must be a full-time student; have at least a 3.0 GPA; major in a health care-related field; and be a resident of Floyd, Johnson, Magoffin or Martin County.

Verne P. Horne Scholarship
Eligibility: Must demonstrate financial need and have at least a 3.0 high school GPA. Preference given to a student from Floyd, Johnson, Martin or Pike County but open to any student who qualifies on the basis of need. When 2 or more applicants qualify equally as to need and GPA, the award is given to the applicant who can prove to be a descendant of the Johnson or Horne families.

Harris S. Howard Memorial Scholarship
Eligibility: Must be a Kentucky resident, demonstrate the potential for academic excellence and have a desire for achievement.

J. Woodford Howard and Florence Stephens Howard Scholarship
Eligibility: Must be a Breathitt, Floyd, Magoffin or Morgan County resident; exhibit exemplary academic standards and potential for academic excellence; and demonstrate financial need.

Estalene Salisbury Jenkins Book Scholarship for Nursing
Eligibility: Must be a second-year nursing student, have at least a 3.0 GPA and be a resident of Floyd County. Preference given to a female student.

Dr. Nancy B. Johnson Scholarship
Eligibility: Must be a full-time student, maintain a 2.5 to 3.0 GPA and submit a 1-page essay on "Why a College Education is Important to me?"

Eligibility: Preference given to a technical student, a student majoring in teaching, a student in good academic standing and/or a relative of Lynn Ward.

Julie Osborne Lester Memorial Dental Hygiene Scholarship
Eligibility: Must be enrolled in the first year of the dental hygiene program, have unmet financial need, demonstrate potential for academic success and submit an essay explaining why applicant qualifies for the scholarship.
Award: Varies; dental hygiene instrument kit will be provided while recipient is enrolled in the program

Robert E. Looney Humanities Scholarship
Eligibility: Must be a full-time student seeking an AA in the humanities (communication preferred), have at least a 3.0 GPA and demonstrate financial need.

Maintenance and Operations Scholarship
Eligibility: Must have at least a 2.0 GPA and be making satisfactory academic progress. Priority given to an employee or child of a Maintenance and Operations employee.

Newton May Memorial Scholarship
Eligibility: Must demonstrate potential for academic excellence.

Robert V. May Scholarship
Eligibility: Must be a Floyd, Johnson, Martin or Pike County resident; have at least a 3.0 high school GPA; submit an essay; maintain satisfactory academic progress; and demonstrate financial need. Length and subject of essay are at discretion of applicant. Based on applicant's ability to demonstrate a firm grasp of the fundamental rules of the use of language. Education major is preferred but not required.

Marion Mayo and Homer Salisbury Memorial Scholarship
Eligibility: Must demonstrate potential for academic success.

Mountain Comprehensive Care Endowed Scholarship
Eligibility: Must be a second-year human services student and demonstrate the potential for academic success. Preference given to a student who participates in community activities.

Mountain Laurel Endowed Scholarship
Eligibility: Must be a student in a health-related field and demonstrate potential for academic excellence.

Marvin and Florence Music Scholarship
Eligibility: Must be a Floyd, Johnson, Magoffin, Martin or Pike County resident and demonstrate potential for academic excellence.

Wendell Lee Nickell Endowed Scholarship
Eligibility: Must demonstrate the potential for achieving academic excellence; have at least a 2.5 GPA; and be enrolled in a digital information, computer information or broadband/communications technology program. Preference given to a first-generation student.

Susan Sparks Nutter Scholarship
Eligibility: Must be an elementary or secondary education major.

Presidential Scholarship
Eligibility: Must be a Kentucky resident and be enrolled for at least 15 credit hours. Other criteria set by the college on an annual basis.

J. Scott Preston Endowed Scholarship
Eligibility: Must have at least a 2.0 GPA, be a resident of Johnson County and have an interest or involvement in community service.

Alvin Reed Scholarship
Eligibility: Must be a sophomore, have at least a 3.0 GPA, live in the Left Beaver area and plan to transfer to a 4-year institution.

Kent Rose Foundation Inc. Scholarship
Eligibility: Must be a graduating high school senior and be enrolled in the AAS automotive technology program.

Berlie and Jane Salmons Scholarship
Eligibility: Must be an incoming first-generation freshman, have a 2.0–2.9 high school GPA, be receiving no other type of scholarship and demonstrate financial need.

John D. and Connie W. Sammons Scholarship
Eligibility: Must be a full-time student, be interested in math or engineering, have at least a 2.5 GPA and demonstrate potential for academic success.

Ernie Skeen and Ken Weiner Scholarship
Eligibility: Must be a first-generation college student, be a sophomore enrolled full time, be pursuing an AA degree and plan to transfer to a 4-year school.

Accelerating Opportunities Scholarship
Eligibility: Must be enrolled in accelerating opportunities courses, be in good standing with the college and demonstrate financial need. Preference given to a student working toward a GED or a first-generation college student.

Alumni Scholarship
Eligibility: Must be taking at least 3 credit hours, have at least a 2.5 GPA and demonstrate financial need. Preference given to a student enrolled in at least 6 hours.

Eligibility: Must be a current-year high school graduate who finished in the top quartile of graduating class.

Herron-Rodgers Family Scholarship
Eligibility: Must be enrolled full time at the time of award and have at least a 2.5 GPA.

Human Family Scholarship
Eligibility: Must be enrolled in the nursing program and be balancing school and work demands and/or family care, including caring for children, parents and grandparents.

Cierra M. James Scholarship
