#### Admissions requirements:

Adult Professional Studies program: Must be at least 23 years old, have at least 12 semester credit hours (with at least a C average) from accredited colleges, and provide transcripts and references.

Traditional program: 22 ACT or 1020 SAT, 36 Classic Learning Test (CLT), a high school diploma with at least 2.5 GPA or GED. Test-optional application available.

**Criteria used to determine nontraditional status:** Age 23

**Placement/credit examinations:** AP, CLEP, credit by demonstrated competency
