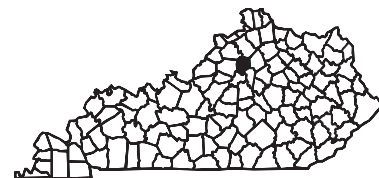

Admission requirements: Official high school transcript, 2.5 cumulative GPA and 18 ACT or 860 SAT (math and reading).

Criteria used to determine nontraditional status: Age 25 or older

Placement/credit examinations: AP, CLEP, institutional test

Application deadlines: Rolling, Early Admission deadline is November 1. Submit application by February 15 for scholarship consideration.
