

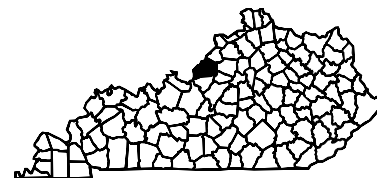

Admission requirements: High school diploma or GED, ACT/SAT or entrance exam scores meeting minimum requirement. Minimum score requirement varies depending on program of study.

Criteria used to determine nontraditional status:
Applicants are considered adult students if their high school graduation date was prior to the current year.

Placement/credit examinations: Bypass examinations to determine if applicants can receive credit for basic level classes.

Application deadlines: Beginning of quarter
