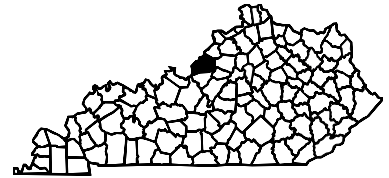

Sullivan University is a private proprietary university in Jefferson County with campuses in Louisville, Lexington, Fort Knox and Carlisle, as well as centers in Louisa and Northern Kentucky. It has about 4,800 students, with 83% from Kentucky and 81% full time. The school operates on a quarter system and is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.

Admission requirements: High school diploma or GED; 18 ACT, 940 SAT; Admissions Assessment Placement Test. Some programs require a 19 ACT/995 SAT.

Criteria used to determine nontraditional status: Any student who has been out of school five years or more
