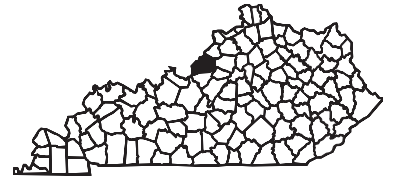

**Admission requirements:** Vary by college and curriculum.  
Based primarily on high school courses and grades, performance on the ACT or SAT, and high school rank.

**Criteria used to determine nontraditional status:** Age 25 or older and a high school graduate or GED recipient for adult students

**Placement/credit examinations:** AP, CLEP, institutional test/ placement tests, IB, TOEFL, DSST

**Application deadlines:** December 15 for freshman Mentored Scholarships and Guaranteed Entrance Programs  
January 15 for general freshman scholarships  
February 15 (priority) for new freshmen

Scholarship deadlines for adult, community college and non-resident transfers vary. Visit <http://louisville.edu/admissions/apply/transfer/> for deadlines. Transfer students should apply at least 6 weeks before start of term.
