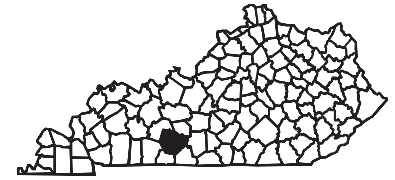

Admission requirements: Applicants with a 2.5 unweighted GPA or an ACT composite score of 20 may qualify for guaranteed admission. For more information visit www.wku.edu/admissions.

Criteria used to determine nontraditional status: Age 25 or older

Placement/credit examinations: ACT, AP, CLEP, IB, SAT, institutional test

Application deadlines: Fall: August 1
Spring: January 1

Students wishing to be considered for most merit-based university scholarships should be admitted to WKU by January 15 with ACT/ SAT scores and transcripts on file.

Pre-enrollment fees and deposits:

Application for admission: \$45 (nonrefundable)
Housing deposit: \$150 (refund details at www.wku.edu/housing)
Topper Orientation Program: \$75 one-time advising and registration fee. Fee includes one guest pass for parent/family orientation.
