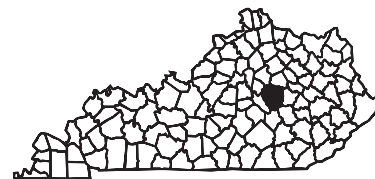

Admission requirements: ACT and/or SAT, minimum 2.0 GPA. The scholastic requirements for guaranteed admission are 2.5 unweighted GPA; minimum 18 ACT English and minimum 20 ACT reading or minimum 490 SAT reading/writing; and minimum 19 ACT math or minimum 480 SAT math. Students who do not meet admissions benchmarks may be admitted through the Success First program.
