Adult Professional Studies program: Must be at least 23 years old, have at least 12 semester credit hours (with at least a C average) from accredited colleges, and provide transcripts and references.

Traditional program: A high school diploma with at least 2.5 GPA or a GED. Asbury University is test optional.

Criteria used to determine nontraditional status: Age 23
