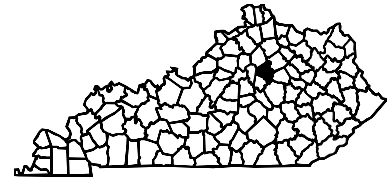

Admission requirements: Test scores (ACT or SAT) are optional. Combination of ACT or SAT (for test submitters), GPA, precollege curriculum, positive recommendations. Admissions essay, extracurricular involvement.

Criteria used to determine nontraditional status: Anyone who does not attend immediately following high school graduation or transfer directly from another postsecondary institution.

Placement/credit examinations: AP, IB

Application deadlines: Fall: October 15 (Early Action #1)
November 15 (Early Action #2)
February 1 (regular decision)
Winter: December 1
