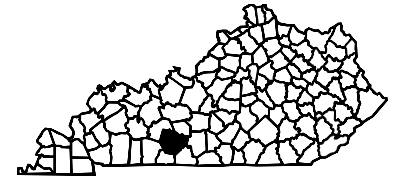

Admission requirements: ACT or SAT required for students below a 2.5 unweighted GPA. Students with a 2.5 or greater do not need to submit test scores for admission. All students must have at least a 2.0 unweighted GPA and a Composite Admission Index score of at least 60.

Criteria used to determine nontraditional status: Age 25 or older

Placement/credit examinations: ACT, AP, CLEP, IB, SAT, institutional test

Application deadlines: Fall: August 1
Spring: January 1

Pre-enrollment fees and deposits:

Application for admission: \$50 (Nonrefundable)
Housing application fee: \$75 (Nonrefundable)
Topper Orientation Program: \$50 one-time advising and registration fee. The student can bring up to 2 guests at \$25 per guest.
