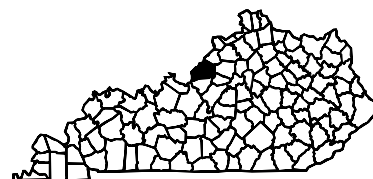

Admission requirements: Based on a review of the quality of high school courses, GPA, leadership, service, honors, activities, recommendations, and employment. Test scores are used in the admission process for those who choose to submit an ACT or SAT.

Application deadlines: Two weeks before registering. The admission application deadline for students applying for scholarship consideration is February 1. Early action deadline is November 1. Transfer admission and adult admission: rolling.
