**Chapters from “Getting In,” the State’s College  
Planning Guide, Now Available in Audio Format**

**FRANKFORT, Ky. (Dec. 7, 2020)** — Portions of the newest edition of “Getting In,” Kentucky’s college planning guide, can now be downloaded in an audio file from the Kentucky Higher Education Assistance Authority (KHEAA) [website](#).

“I want to ensure all Kentuckians have the information they need to make informed choices about continuing education after high school, whether they are interested in technical studies or college classes,” said Gov. Andy Beshear. “Many Kentucky students and their families continue to find resources like ‘Getting In’ helpful and having this information available in multiple formats makes it accessible to a larger population. Having an audio version will make planning for college easier for Kentucky high school students, particularly those who are visually impaired.”

The audio versions include Chapter One, a guide to college admissions, and the first part of Chapter Two, which helps students and parents navigate the financial aid process.

People who access the audio version can listen to the complete chapter-long recordings or to separate sections that deal with specific topics, such as planning for college or finding financial aid.
