College-planning information now available as audio files

FRANKFORT, Ky. (July 9, 2021) — Parts of the newest edition of “Getting In,” Kentucky’s college planning guide, are now available in audio form from the Kentucky Higher Education Assistance Authority (KHEAA).

“Inclusion, equality and diversity are top priorities for our administration, and providing resources for visually impaired students is a critical part of that effort,” said Gov. Andy Beshear. “An audio version of this annual publication, which is used by many school counselors across the state, helps ensure that all students have the information they need about accessing higher education and pursuing their future goals through college or technical training.”

Chapter One of “Getting In” provides students and families with information about getting admitted to colleges and technical schools.

Information about the financial aid process is available in Chapter Two of the book, which KHEAA has published every year since 1976.

Individuals who access the audio version of the guide can listen to the complete chapter-long recordings or to particular sections of interest that deal with specific topics, such as planning for college or finding financial aid.

From the Students section on kheaa.com, click on the Other Resources button, then Publications and then College Planning. From the Families section, click on Publications, then College Planning and look for Getting In: Class of 2022 (with audio).

KHEAA is the state agency that administers the Kentucky Educational Excellence Scholarship (KEES), need-based grants and other programs to help students pay their higher education expenses. Kentucky Lottery funds pay for many of those programs.
